

AGREEMENT TO SERVE AS MAJOR PROFESSOR

(For Current Graduate Students)

The Environmental Toxicology Graduate Student listed below has been working in your laboratory for one or more quarters. Please discuss with this student your willingness to serve or not serve as his/her major professor. You should note that each student is allowed to rotate only one quarter in each lab. If you do not want to serve as a major professor, please inform the student and the program's Student Affairs Officer as soon as possible because the student has up to three quarters during the first year to rotate to find a suitable lab.

Please review the spreadsheet of the student's financial support package; you will find that typically Ph.D. students are supported one year by the E-Tox program, and, if eligible for fellowship support, one year by Graduate Division. The remaining years are up to the faculty to provide support as outlined. Please note that the dollar amounts on the spread sheet are an estimate of expected costs. In the case of a loss of grant funding, the program will make every effort to assist. Please contact program Chair or the Student Affairs Officer if you have any questions regarding the spreadsheet.

In light of the above consideration, the potential major professor is urged to become familiar with the student's academic performance before indicating acceptance. Also, the professor should inform the student in advance as to his general academic and contractual (employment hours, etc.) requirements.
