ENVIRONMENTAL TOXICOLOGY Procedures for Qualifying Examination Nomination:

❖ Environmental Toxicology students who plan to take their qualifying Exam must begin planning as early as a quarter before they plan to take the examination. Students are required to first obtain approval from the program by submitting the Environmental Toxicology Qualifying Examination Nomination Form no later than the first day of the quarter. However, students may submit their nominations earlier if they wish.

The nomination procedure allows students to nominate the first three members of the committee (Major Professor, Outside Member, Chair).

Before submitting these names the student should confirm with each member their willingness and availability to serve.

- ❖ One CSAC meeting will be set during the first week of each quarter in which the CSAC members will review the Qualifying Exam Committee Member Nominations, approve or disapprove of them, and make recommendations for the three alternate members of the committee. If CSAC disapproves of any of the faculty suggested by the student, the committee will provide alternate names.
- ❖ The BSGSAC Office will e-mail the student CSAC's recommendations.
- ❖ Of the three alternate recommendations made by CSAC the student may choose two. It is the student's responsibility to confirm the faculty's wiliness to serve. It is also the student's responsibility to set the date, time, and location of the examination.
- ❖ Once the committee is confirmed, the student completes a Form 3 nominating the Qualifying Exam Committee members and giving the date of the examination. This form is to be signed by the Graduate Advisor/Program Chair and sent to Graduate Division for final approval. Examinations cannot take place until the Graduate Division issues the final approval.
